The Racial and Social Justice Committee of the Prince George's County Educators' Association has established a scholarship fund. Scholarships will be awarded to Prince George's County high school seniors who will graduate from Prince George's County public high schools in the 2022-2023 school year. Scholarships are a minimum of \$1000.00 and will be given in recognition of outstanding academic performance, leadership qualities, and financial need.

The two types of scholarships offered are:

- 1. Merit
- 2. Merit/Need

### **Eligibility Requirements**

You are eligible to apply if:

- You are currently a 12th-grade student who has been attending Prince George's County Public High Schools for a minimum of two (2) years.
- You are a graduate of a Prince George's County public high school by June 2023.
- You are accepted to an accredited college/university, trade/technical school, or post-secondary institution.
- You are in good academic standing with at least a "B" average or the equivalent in grades 9 -12.
- You are a good citizen at school and in the community.
- You can provide evidence that you have exhibited leadership qualities in school and/or your community.

### All applicants must submit the following:

- The attached two-page application.
- A current resumé.
- An up-to-date official transcript that includes grades received so far in applicant's senior year.
- A recent professional or graduation photograph (non-returnable) please do not provide a photocopied picture.
- Three references (Two (2) from a teacher or counselor and One (1) from a member of your community).

### Deadline:

All information must be submitted by April 6, 2023 (no exceptions). The completed application, transcript, and all appropriate documents should be emailed together (in a single package) to the following addresses: **Devin Nixon at dnixon@pgcea.org.** The email's subject must be: **Racial/Social Justice Committee & Foundation Scholarship Applications.**
